TEACHING METHOD

GENERAL RULES

ATTENDANCE:

Students are expected to be present in school on all working days as per the dates given in the calendar. It is mandatory to attend all the classes as laid out in the time table.

- ❖ Once the student is inside the school campus, he or she is not allowed to leave without proper permission granted by the head of the institution. Leave of half day not encouraged.
- ❖ If a student is absent from school, the reason of his/her absence must be recorded the relevant section of the school diary and shown to the class teacher. The parents or guardians must sign this entry. This is mandatory and will be dealt strictly in failure to do so.
- ❖ If a student is absent for four or more days because of illness, a medical certifies should be produced.
- ❖ A student suffering from contagious diseases like measles, chicken fox, jaundice, mumps, etc. Must not be sent to school till the quarantine period is over.

Haircut, Nail, Make-up & Ornaments:

- ❖ Boys are not allowed to have long or fancy hairdos.
- ❖ Girls with long hair must tie and pin up their hair.
- ❖ Boys must not grow a beard and wear earrings.
- ❖ Both boys and girls must keep their nails short and clean without any nail enamel.
- ❖ Make-up, kajal, hair colouring, lipstick, lip-balm, body tattoos are not permitted.
- ❖ No student is allowed to wear dangles, hoops, bangles, anklets, chains, fancy finger rings etc.
- ❖ Girls must not wear their skirts above the knee (length should be as per school specification).

Examinations and Promotion

- ❖ Periodic progress Report after each Pre Mid Term / Mid Term / Post Mid Term examinations given to the parents to keep them informed of the progress of their ward. Parents are requested to attend all PTA meetings.
- ❖ SDS is following an on-going system of evaluation, a student's performance will judge on the basis of Scholastic & Co- scholastic assessment throughout the year for classes I to X.
- ❖ Subject wise totals are converted into grades, as per CBSE guidelines.

Promotion Criteria

Students will have to secure 40% marks in all subjects for promotion.

FINAL EXAMINATIONS: In matters related to promotions the Principal and Management decision is final. The name of any student who fails for two consecutive years is automatically struck off the school rolls. If a student of Class IX fails to score required pass marks in three subjects or if he fails to score the required percentage of marks in the exams, he/she will not be promoted to Class X.

INFORMATION REGARDING ADMISSION:

From Class -1 onwards a student will be admitted only after submission of a Transfer Certificate from the previous school. Admission is subject to a student qualifying entrance examination and availability of seats.

The admission is also subject to the following:

- ❖ Verification of Original Birth Certificate
- ❖ Submission of Original Mark Sheet Report Card of the last exam of the last class attended, (not applicable for KG)
- ❖ Transfer Certificate (Classes I and above) (to be counter signed by District Elementary Education Officer in case of interstate/inter board transfer)
- ❖ Deposition of admission fees within the prescribed date.
- ❖ Incomplete and illegible Registration forms will not be accepted.

GENERAL RULES & FEE STRUCTURE:

- ❖ The amount deposited towards Registration and Admission for particular year will neither be refunded nor transferred to any other year or towards sibling's fee.
- ❖ Tuition fees are charged for 12 months as indicated in the fee receipt. Fees are to be paid monthly and must be paid by the 20th of each month.
- ❖ Student will be required to pay fees for June & July before the Summer Vacation and fees for March should be cleared by Feb. 20th.
- ❖ Annual fee, Tuition fee and Transport fees will be automatically linked with the rise in the price index and may be increased by about 10 - 15% at the beginning of a subsequent session as determined by the School's Management.
